

HGV Technician Responsibilities

- Excellent shift pattern
- Very competitive salary - negotiable dependant on experience
- To work safely and keep others safe in accordance with safety standards.
- Inspection of in-house HGV Units and Trailers, including Walking Floor and Tipping Trailers.
- To carry out repairs to vehicles identified at inspection or reported by drivers from their daily defect report.
- To attend and carry out roadside repairs and punctures.
- To complete inspection and defect rectification paperwork as required.

Key Requirements

- Responsible, dependable, and a committed individual who can work within a dedicated workshop team.
- Experience of HGV repair and have the training documentation to support this.
- Work on your own initiative and the willingness to resolve issues quickly and effectively.
- Have driving license to attend roadside repairs. Ideally the successful applicant would also have a C + E HGV license, although this is not essential.
- Good IT skills and an appetite to embrace new technology.
- Excellent communication skills
- A good team player.

Key tasks

- To carry out periodical inspections and complete the required paperwork.
- To rectify vehicle defects.
- To attend off site repairs to vehicles.
- Complete Minor accident repairs
- Repairs to trailer Sheeting Systems
- Ensure safety technology is working correctly (Cameras, Inclometers)
- To work safely and ensure the safety of others.

Key results/objectives

- Vehicles maintained to a high standard 100% MOT first time pass rate.
- Vehicle downtime minimised.
- Vehicles to be smart and tidy in appearance.
- Responsible for all equipment used in the workshop.
